- High-quality educational program with an early literacy focus.
- Free for all 4-year-olds who reside in the state of Florida.
- Participating children must be 4 years of age on or before September 1.
- Parents whose children are born from February 2 through

September 1 of a calendar year may choose to enroll their child

- either that year or the next when the child is 5, prior to being enrolled in kindergarten.
- Parent choice is a priority. Both private and public child care providers participate.
